

RESTORATION OF VIADUCT OVER RIVER LUNE AT CROOK O'LUNE WEST, CATON, NEAR LANCASTER

Summary:

Restoration of 90m long former twin track railway bridge over River Lune, forming part of the Luneside Millennium Walk.



PROJECT DETAILS

Extensive scaffolding for access, working platforms and temporary encapsulation. Removal of wrought iron parapets, footpath surfacing and timber bridge deck. Shotblasting and painting of six wrought iron bridge arches spanning masonry piers, new timber deck in african hardwood covered with anti-slip panels, refurbish and refit parapets, reinstate footpath / cycleway.

Extensive environmental protection works required and liaison with the Environment Agency.
