PROJECT DETAILS

For this contract AE Yates Trenchless Solutions Ltd had to get their passports out and venture further afield than normal, we became international rescue sending our drilling crew and thunderbird 40/45 (formally known as Astec 40/45) over to Ireland to install some new water mains around the beautiful city of Cork. We were working in a Joint Venture with Irish contractor McGuinty & O'Shea, We were drilling in the new water mains and McGuinty & O'Shea were doing the service connections and excavating of pits. This was a challenging job due to the tight working room we had available and the very varied ground conditions we encountered. The drilling was successful and completed with project programme period. All parties involved were happy with the outcome of the project given the challenging conditions we all had to work in.

Ground Conditions: Made ground and sandy clay with some cobbles.
